SAMPLE

2100 young people aged 16-20

300 young people surveyed per country: **each sample is representative** based on the following criteria: gender, age, region, metropolitan area category and employment status.

Data within each country has been adjusted to reflect the demographic profile of young people based on the most recent official data.

The "overall" results have not been weighted to reflect the actual weight of each country.

Survey conducted online with a self-administered questionnaire via the Ipsos proprietary panel

Field : From 16 October to 13 November 2023



The results presented in this report are those of the average of the 7 countries surveyed.






UZ Health and care, a sector with real potential to attract young Europeans






What are the most important criteria when choosing a career ?












Raising awareness of care professions during studies



"Which of the following people would you be most interested in talking to about care professions and would you be likely to follow on social networks (Instagram, Facebook, Twitter (X), etc.)?" Base : To the French (n=300) 57% of youth would be interested in hearing from a practicing counselor (*) A female medical student who shares her daily life as a student, but who also speaks out on 37% major health issues and gives advice on well-being, like Marine Lorphelin, for example. An emergency room doctor who explains his job, talks about medicine and current events, and 26% gives health advice in the form of videos on YouTube, such as Doctor FX* **Carers talk about their daily life** in the places where they work, about what they do to help elderly and disabled people, but also about what they like about their work and how they live their 17% profession, for example "La Voix des Soignants" or "La souffrance des soignants", available on the most popular platforms*. Nurses and healthcare assistants blog about their daily work and share anecdotes about situations they encounter in hospitals and emergency rooms, such as Infirmière de nuit (Night 14% Nurse) or Nurse Constance*. A politician who has major responsibilities in the management of the French health system and who speaks out on its issues, the situation of health workers and hospitals, such as the 6% Minister of Health.
